A total of 386 44-tonners were built by General Electric between 1940 and 1956. They became some of the first diesel-electric locomotives to find widespread acceptance, marking the beginning of the end for the steam era. In 2023, four non-profit organizations are joining forces to restore three of these classic 75-year-old locomotives to operation in three different northeastern states.
